

# 1. Configuring Web browsers for the Baltic languages

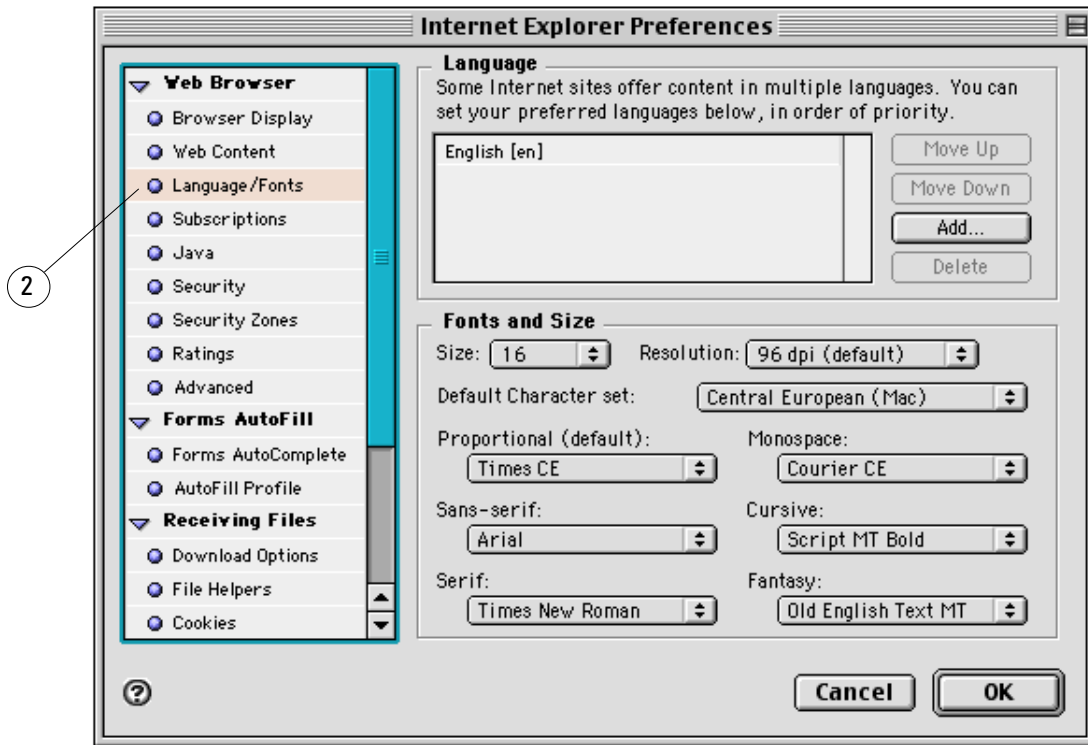
Microsoft Internet Explorer 5.0 for Macintosh

Before configuring MS Internet Explorer 5.0 for Estonian, Latvian or Lithuanian please ensure that you have at least one Apple CE font, (eg. Times CE, Helvetica CE) installed on your Macintosh system. Such fonts are included as part of the [Baltic Utilities](#) software package.

1. Start MS Internet Explorer 5.0 and from the Edit menu choose the Preferences... command.



2. Click on Language/Fonts and set the following parameters located in the Fonts and Size area:

Default Character set:	Central European (Mac)
Proportional (default):	Times CE
Monospace:	Courier CE

Click on OK to save your new preferences.

3. Check that the Baltic text is displaying all diacritics correctly by trying out the following popular Baltic Web sites:
