

2. Installing the Netscape Baltic & Cyrillic Patch

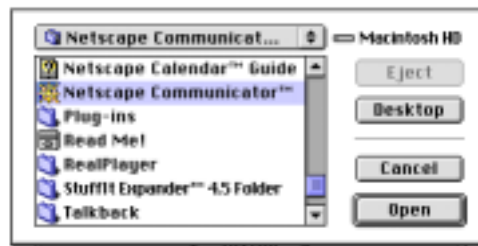
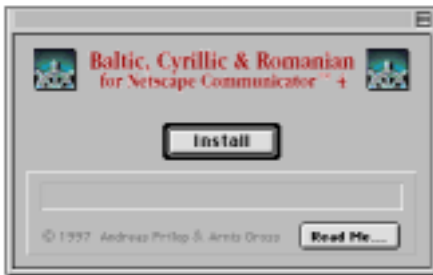
Netscape Navigator/Communicator 4.x for Macintosh

Mac OS 7.6
Mac OS 8.x
Mac OS 9.x



This patch is intended for use with all Netscape Navigator/Communicator 4 versions (not including 4.6 and 4.7). It will enable you to read Web pages in Latvian, Lithuanian, Romanian and Ukrainian. For the Baltic languages you will also require at least one Apple CE font, (eg. Times CE, Helvetica CE) installed on your Macintosh system. Such fonts are included as part of the [Baltic Utilities](#) software package.

1. Make a copy of Netscape Communicator and rename it, for example, **Netscape Communicator B&C**.
2. Start the Installer Netscape 4 Balt/Cyr Support, click on **Install** and open the file **Netscape Communicator B&C**.



3. Start **Netscape Communicator B&C** and from the Edit menu choose the Preferences... command.
4. Click on Fonts and set the following parameters located in the My Fonts area:

For the Encoding:	Baltic
Variable Width font:	Times CE
Fixed Width font:	Courier CE

Choose the **Use my fonts, overriding page-specified fonts** option. Click on OK to save your new preferences.

5. While visiting the desired Baltic Web page as a further check go to the **View** menu and **Character Set...** command and see that the **Baltic (ISO-8859-13)** option is checked.

Note: Netscape Navigator/Communicator 6 is the first Netscape Web browser that includes built-in Baltic language support.
