

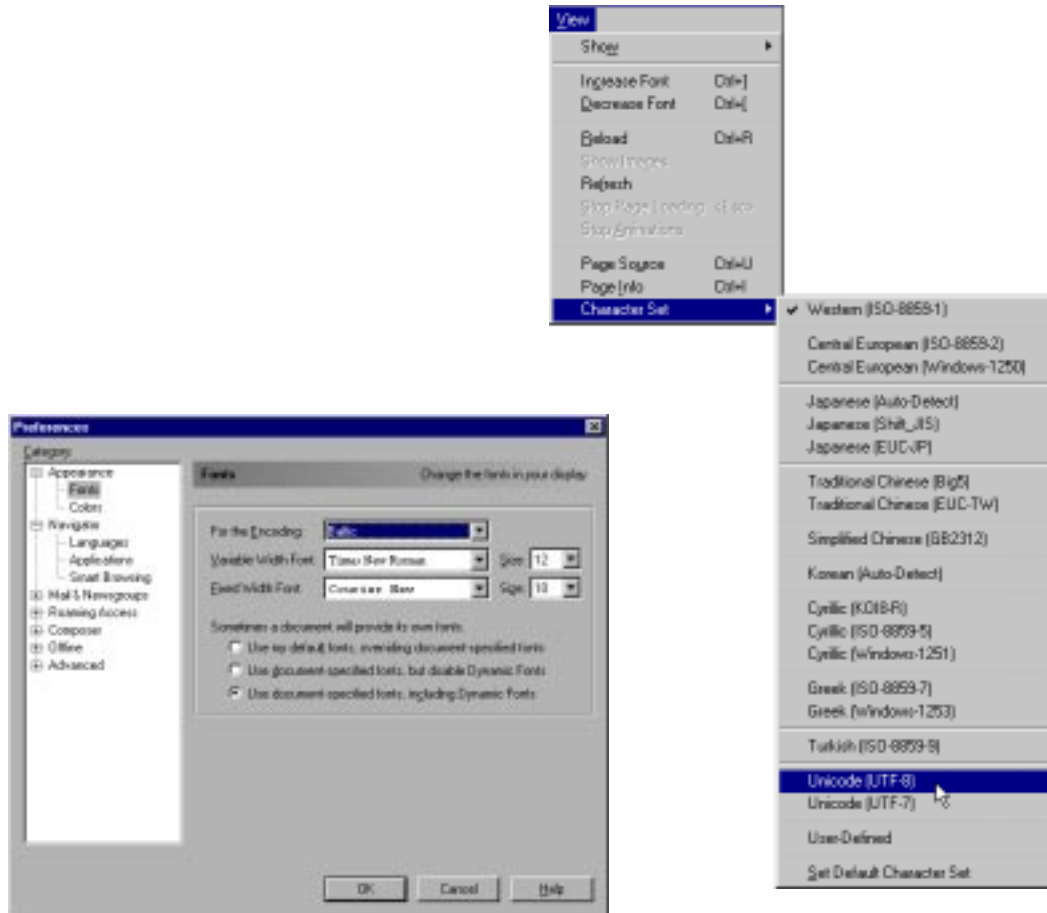
1. Configuring Web browsers for the Baltic languages

1. On the **Edit** menu, select **Preferences...**, and then in the Preferences dialog box select Fonts (under Appearance) and choose the variable-width and fixed-width fonts to be used for the Baltic encoding.



2. From the Character Set menu you can see which character set or code page Netscape Navigator 4.7x has chosen to view the current Baltic Web page. Choose the **Unicode (UTF-8)** encoding and make it the default by selecting the last item on the menu.
3. Check that the Baltic text is displaying all diacritics correctly by trying out the following popular Baltic Web sites:
